- It is recommended that two people perform the installation. Injury and/or damage can result from dropping or mishandling the display.
- The enclosed instructions are an aid to installation and cannot cover all eventualities, if you have any concerns regarding the mounting of the frame or brackets you should consult an expert.
- CAUTION: Before installation the mounting area should be checked that it is suitable for the weight of the bracket and screen and is free from pipes, electric cables or any other obstructions.









STEP1A Solid concrete mounting




STEP1B Woodstud mounting




STEP2
